The 2010 Sycamore J.H.S. Indoor Drumline Show

“The Golden Spud” is inspired by many different treasure hunting movies and video games.

Our show will tell a short story about treasure hunters who are attempting to steal the coveted golden idol (a Mr. Potato Head painted gold) from a temple in the jungle.

A native tribe (battery members) will attempt to protect their idol (with the help of a few other jungle traps). The treasure hunters (pit members) will soon realize that this treasure might be more trouble than it’s worth!



The show will include many of the stereotypical effects and props that any good treasure-hunting story should have. A gold idol, angry tribes people, trees, a temple of doom, whips, snakes, tribal masks and even a loud boomy voice warning the treasure hunters not to steal the idol. The goal is to tell a fun, light-hearted, entertaining story that leaves the audience smiling.

Costumes –Battery members dressed as the guardians of the jungle (tribes people) with masks
Pit members – Indiana Jones costumes

Sycamore 2010 Show Timeline

“The Golden Spud”

Part 1 (Introduction) :30

One of the Treasure hunters creeps over towards the gold idol in the middle of the jungle (Battery members are hidden behind trees) Pit plays mysterious music. As soon as the Treasure hunter touches the idol, the trees begin to shake and a loud voice warns him of the wrath of the jungle. The battery members come out from behind the trees

Part 2 – “Return the Spud!” 1:00

Battery (wearing masks) chases the treasure hunter away and plays an angry tribal sounding beat.

Part 3 – “Snakes” 1:00

The Treasure hunters try to take the idol again but this time the snakes protect it. A softer musical section with snake sound effects and snake visuals (dancers with ‘snake flags’?)

Part 4 – “Tribal Ritual” 1:30

The Battery returns (no masks this time... face paint?) to celebrate around their idol. A Jungle-like celebration beat is played

Part 5 – “Nevermind” :30

The Treasure hunters see what the idol means to the tribes people and decide to leave the idol in the jungle (maybe). The end. (possible ending – one of them grabs it and runs out the door)
